We've built the list around the growers, winemakers and importers who've been part of AngloThai from the start; people who care about the land, the craft, the vintage.

Wines with a sense of place; alive with energy.

Travels through Central Europe have taken us to growers working in less-charted territory, particularly Austria. Cooler climates, modern methods, and a boldness that sits well with how we cook.

Our signature wines, Rufus and Aubretia, named after John and Desiree's children, are made with Nibiru in Austria's Kamptal region. Löss soils: clay, sand, silt, bedrock, minerals. The result is wines of minerality, freshness and depth; qualities that define our favourite style of wines.

The list is ordered by distance, starting close to home and moving outward. Wines close to home tend to make sense with the food with a sense of ease, then the further you go, the more contrast and curiosity. A way of thinking about flavour that reflects how we cook, who we are and bridges the distance from here to Thailand.
